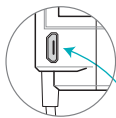

## RECHARGING VRCHARGE

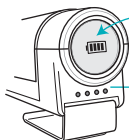
Using the supplied recharging cable, plug the Micro-USB end into VRCHARGE and the other end into any USB power source. Fully charged unit shows 4 solid, non-blinking LEDs.



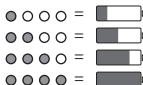
Micro-USB input

## CHARGING GEAR VR

- 1 Plug built-in Micro-USB cable into your GEAR VR goggles. Charging should begin automatically – if it doesn't, press the **power button**.
- 2 Using built-in clip, place VRCharge comfortably over strap.

Designed to work with or without headphones.

- Unit's LEDs will stay on when in use – This will not affect performance.
- Unit can be shut off by either double clicking power button, or unplugging from Gear VR
