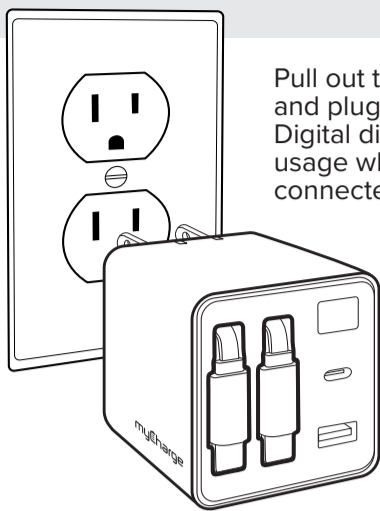


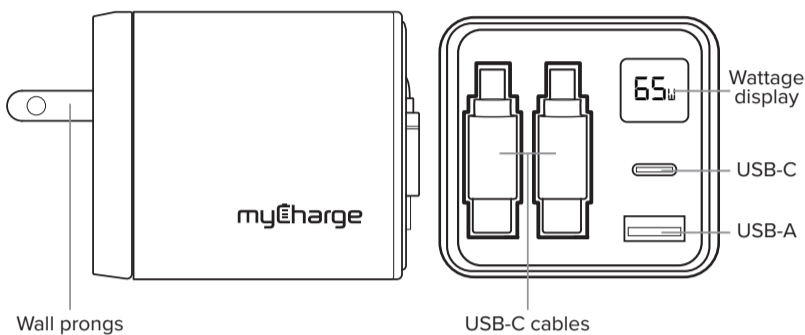
# RetractaPower 65W

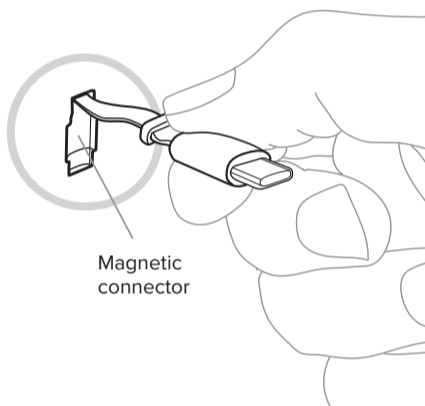


### RETRACTABLE CABLE

Pull slightly and cable will retract into powerbank.

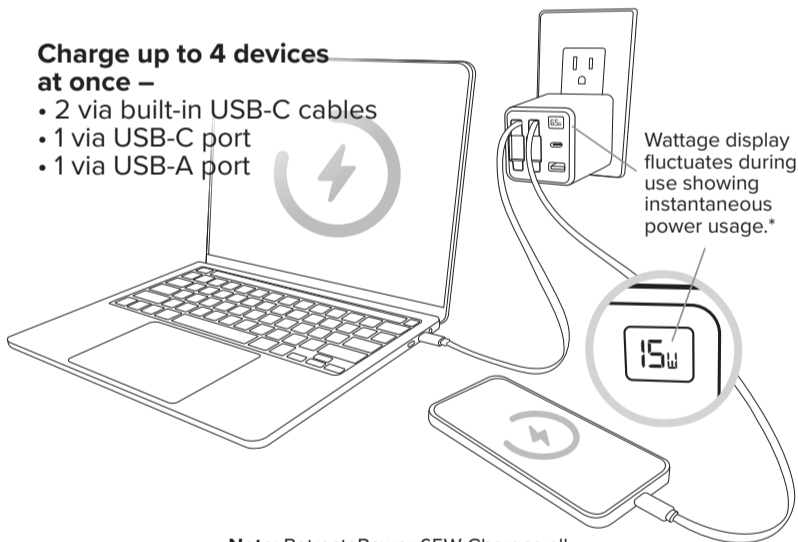
The magnetic connector holds cable in place.
